Establishment of resilient market linkages to foster economic growth.

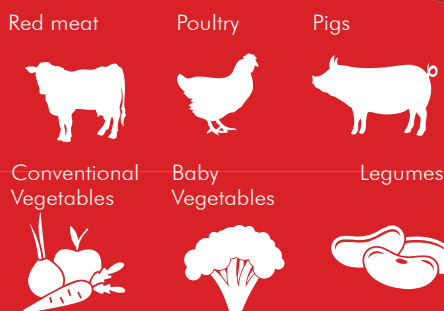
Targeted beneficiaries:
